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Financial explanation

As of 2024, Artemis has officially become a foundation, making this our first financial report. This year, Artemis did not yet have its own bank account, so our funds were managed by the Space Engineering Department of the Aerospace Engineering faculty at TU Delft. For 2024, we were allocated a budget of €5.000. The majority of this budget was spent on Space Bars, a key activity for our society. Additionally, we used part of the funds to purchase board polos, ensuring that board members are easily recognizable during events. This helps them serve as a first point of contact between students, professors, and companies. Organizational costs were also necessary to maintain Artemis' operations. Beyond this budget, we successfully obtained a FAST Fund, which enabled us to organize a career event and acquire hoodies and a banner to enhance Artemis' visibility. We also received student contributions, which were specifically used to organize the end-of-year BBQ. To meet the requirements for ANBI status, we have minimized net income, ensuring that Artemis does not generate a profit. Furthermore, over 90% of our expenditures directly or indirectly serve the public interest.
